## delete symbol

**command:** SDEL <name>

Deletes a previously defined symbol in the current local symbol set or, if qualifier /GLOBAL is entered, in the global symbol set. The whole local symbol set is deleted also by the RETURN statement.

### parameters

- <name> *parameter type: string*  
Name of symbol to be deleted.

### qualifiers

- /global  
The symbol is deleted in the global symbol set.

### examples

```
sdel OLDSYM  
deletes local symbol "OLDSYM"
```

```
sdef/global OLDSYM  
deletes global symbol "OLDSYM"
```
